

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, retain, and protect information when you visit www.mowerymedspa.com.

We may collect information you provide to us, including your name, phone number, email address, appointment information, payment information, and information you choose to provide about your health, treatments, or medical history.

Our website may also automatically collect basic information such as your IP address, browser type, device information, and website activity through cookies and similar technologies.

How We Use Your Information

- Send promotional communications when permitted by law
- Protect our business and prevent fraud
- Comply with applicable laws and regulations

Health Information

Because we provide aesthetic and/or medical services, we may collect sensitive health and treatment information. We take reasonable steps to protect this information and use it only for appropriate business, treatment, and legal purposes.

If our business is subject to HIPAA, our separate **Notice of Privacy Practices** will also apply.

HIPPA notice of Privacy Practice

Mowery Med Spa is committed to protecting the privacy of your health information. This notice explains how we may use and share your health information and the rights you have regarding that information.

How We May Use or Share Your Health Information

We may use or share your health information when necessary to:

- **Provide treatment** and coordinate your care.
- **Process payment** for services provided to you.
- **Operate our practice**, including scheduling, quality improvement, and administrative activities.
- **Contact you** about appointments, treatments, services, or other healthcare-related matters.
- **Comply with applicable laws** and respond to legally authorized requests.
- Address certain public health, safety, workers' compensation, law enforcement, or legal matters when permitted or required by law.

We will not use or disclose your health information for purposes other than those described in this notice without your written authorization when authorization is required by law.

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request a copy of your medical or health records.
- Ask us to correct information you believe is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Request confidential communication, such as asking us to contact you in a particular way or at a particular location.
- Ask us to restrict certain uses or disclosures of your health information.
- Request an accounting of certain disclosures of your health information.
- Receive a paper or electronic copy of this Notice of Privacy Practices.
- Choose someone to act on your behalf when legally authorized.
- File a complaint if you believe your privacy rights have been violated.

We will not retaliate against you for filing a privacy complaint.

Our Responsibilities

We are required by law to maintain the privacy and security of your protected health information, provide you with this notice, and follow the privacy practices described in it. If a breach occurs that may compromise the privacy or security of your protected health information, we will provide notice as required by law.

We may update this notice from time to time. Any revised notice will be made available upon request and posted on our website when required.
